**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS,  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 774 PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF  
AN ELECTION JUDGE AND ALTERNATE ELECTION JUDGE FOR THE  
MAY 4, 2019 MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND FOR THE ELECTION  
EQUIPMENT. \* \* \* \* \***

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE,  
TEXAS:**


Section 1. In accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, the City Council ordered a General Municipal Election and a Special Municipal Election on Saturday, May 4, 2019.

Section 2. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the person appointed by City Council to act as Election Judge will not be able to fulfill that appointment; therefore, City Council appoints as Election Officers Katherine Bodron - Presiding Judge and Gina Gunn - Alternate Presiding Judge.

Section 3. The City Secretary is directed to provide a copy of this Ordinance and the other written information required by Section 32.009 of the Texas Election Code to each judge. The presiding Judge shall have the authority to appoint the necessary clerks to assist in the holding of said elections, but in no event, shall the Presiding Judge appoint less than two (2) clerks. Unless otherwise required to act in the capacity of Presiding Judge, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall also serve as clerk of the election. The Presiding Judge and the Alternate Presiding Judge shall also serve as the early voting ballot board for such election; and the Presiding Judge of the election precinct shall also serve as the presiding officer of such board.

Section 4. The City Secretary is authorized to rent the "Express Vote BMD Terminal" voting system to be used along with paper ballots.
